SEMINAR CONTENT:

Appraisers recognize that they have regulatory obligations, but recognizing and understanding all of the various Federal and State laws and regulations that govern appraisers can be challenging. This seminar is designed to help participants recognize and understand the laws and regulations most important to appraisers at a federal and state level. By being better informed, you'll be able to establish a clear path to maintaining compliance and effectively reconcile conflicting interpretations and requests from clients. A thorough understanding of applicable appraiser regulatory obligations will also increase your efficiency.

AT THIS SEMINAR, PARTICIPANTS WILL:

- Learn and understand how the Dodd-Frank Act amended FIREAA and its effects on appraisers;
- Review the significant changes to the Interagency Appraisal and Evaluation Guidelines;
- Identify the expanded powers, duties, and policy statements of the ASC;
- Become familiar with recent upcoming changes to the AQB Real Property Appraiser Qualifications Criteria;
- Learn and understand the content and amendments of the California Real Estate Appraisers' Licensing and Certification law;
- Learn to recognize the OREA requirements for the registration of AMCs, the definition of "controlling person" in an AMC, and what actions by an AMC are prohibited or permitted; and
- Learn and understand the content and amendment of the regulations found in California's Code of Professions, Title 10, Chapter 6.5 Real Estate Appraisers.
